Alabama Teen Pregnancy Resources



Between 1991 and 2004, Alabama teenagers gave birth to over 143,000 babies. Research shows that 8,288 of those births took place in 2004, and Alabama was 42 of 50 states in number of teen pregnancies. That means Alabama has the 8th highest teen pregnancy rate in the United States.

Alabama Public Health Offices offer free, or low cost medical services for those with no medical coverage. Services include birth control, pregnancy testing, and prenatal services. Parents are NOT required, but call for an appointment. Most Public Health offices in Alabama are also WIC offices. Make an appointment there as well for help with the cost of healthy eating during pregnancy and for baby after it is born.

Income Support Offices offer assistance with the cost of food, medical care, and sometimes cash assistance for low income families. If you still live with your parents then their income must be included on the application. If you do not live at home, then you can apply as an individual and only your income and expenses will be considered.

These locations are also good sources of information about other benefits and assistance programs you may be eligible for. If you are unemployed and need a job then utilize your state employment assistance office. You will get access to jobs posted on the internet, resume writing assistance, fax machines, and you can sometimes even get gas cards, bus passes, and clothing vouchers as well.
